

2018 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

General Rules

1. The championship year runs from the 1st January to the 31st December.
2. All club members are eligible for points without needing to register, but please name Burnham-on-Sea as your club in event entry forms whenever possible, both to help the championship secretary and to publicise the club.
3. Points for events organised by this club alone are given without needing to be claimed. For all other events, even if this club is a co-organiser, points need to be claimed by sending the championship secretary a **copy of the results** within **one month** of the event. This is to stop anyone suddenly claiming fistfuls of points at the end of the year and making a nonsense of things.
4. All championship categories are subject to more than one event taking place. There is no minimum number of contenders for the winner to qualify for an award, but if there are ten or more scorers in a category there is also one for the runner-up. Certain categories have additional awards as detailed below.
5. Points for competing are scored for the first ten positions **in class**, but with two bonus points for an overall win or FTD. Class positions are taken to include everyone who competed in the class, even if one of them won an overall award. If an event does not have class divisions the scores are for the first ten places overall. When there were less than ten **starters** in the class (or event) the points are adjusted as follows :-

Championship Categories

Competitors

Points are scored for driving or co-driving on any event organised or jointly organised by the club. There are additional awards for the highest placed lady, and for the second highest if at least six ladies score points.

Marshals

A point is scored for marshalling or officiating on any competition event which the club organises or jointly organises, and is awarded without needing to be claimed. Points can also be scored on certain other events for which the club officially provides marshals, such as the Brean Stages rally. On major club events extra points can be scored for helping with the setting-up. This category is unique in having awards for the first **three** places.

Speed Events

Points can be scored on specified events only, with a maximum of six scores to be counted from the nine meetings listed below. There is one change from last year, with the BARC Llandow sprint replacing the July Castle Combe.

*For two-day events you can score points on either day, but not both.

Stage Rallies

This is effectively two categories in one, as there are separate awards for drivers and co-drivers. Subject to the events running there are eight qualifying rounds this year, as listed below, from which a maximum of six scores can be counted.
